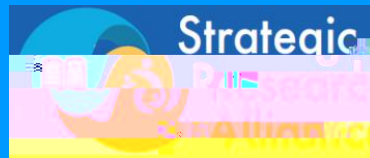

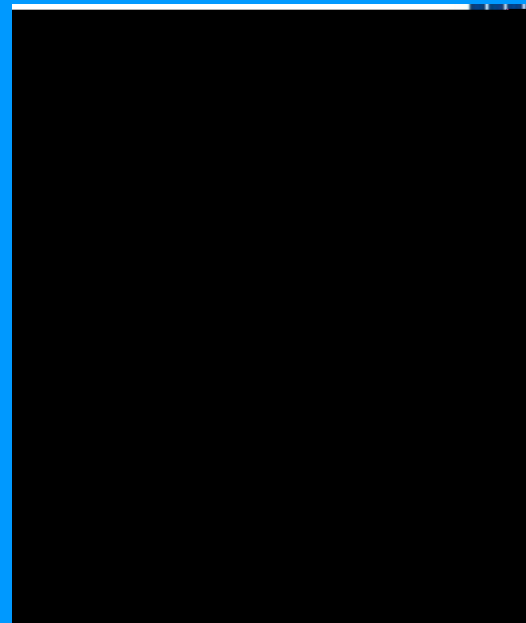
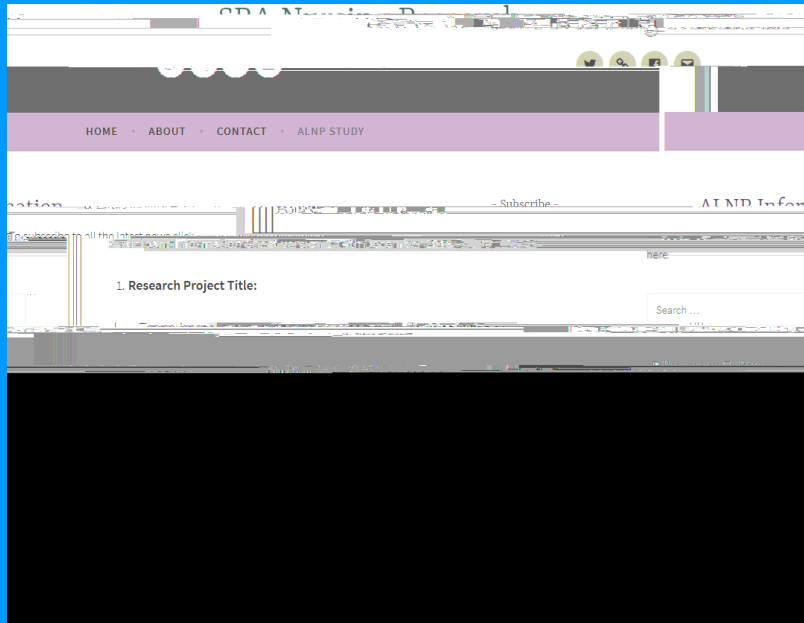


# Why study ANPs?

- Regulation/credentialing?



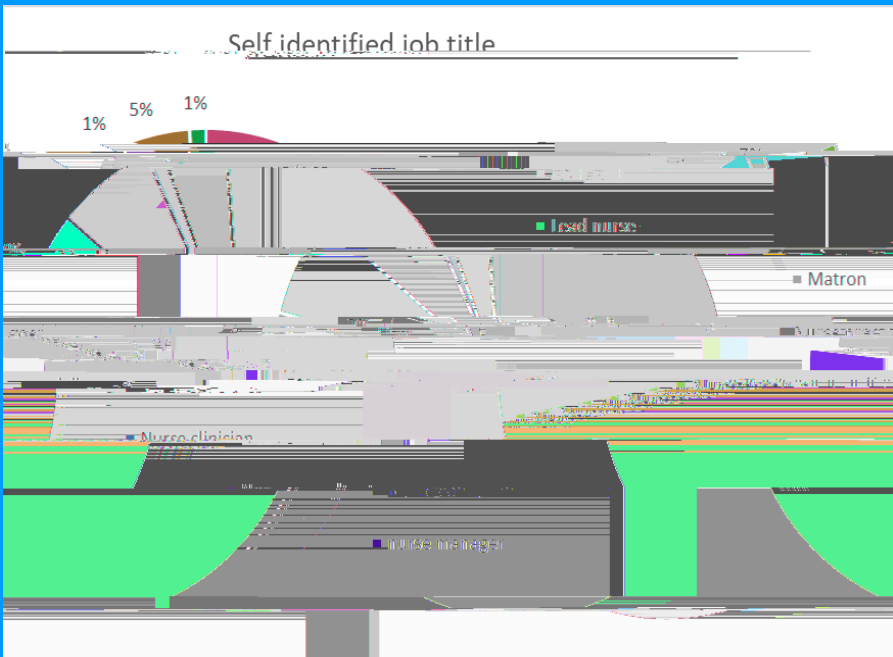
