



Improving outcomes for children and young people with severe mental health conditions

An economic assessment of the NHS Fife Child & Adolescent Mental Health Intensive Therapy Service

Understanding the service

The Scottish Government is committed to ensuring that everyone lives longer, healthier lives at home or in a homely setting and receives high quality healthcare, wherever this is delivered¹. For children and young people with severe mental health conditions this will mean being cared for effectively and safely in their own home or local community wherever this can be achieved, with any necessary hospital stays lasting for as short a time as possible. This study shows that NHS Fife's Child and Adolescent Mental Health (CAMHS) Intensive Therapy Service can support delivery of the Scottish Government's vision.

When NHS Fife closed its child and adolescent mental health inpatient unit in 2002, the board set up a new nurse-led Intensive Therapy Service (ITS) to provide personalised community-focused care for 8-18 year olds. Under the leadership of a Nurse Consultant, the ITS brought together nurses, psychiatrists, psychologists and therapists to offer high-intensity home-

Key benefits of this innovation

For those using the service

The NHS Fife ITS provides a high quality service that results in positive outcomes for service users. Benefits include access to appropriate and effective therapeutic interventions, which result in overall improvements in young people's mental health.

Since the service was set up, scores on the well-established Health of the Nation Outcome Scales for Children and Adolescent (HoNOSCA)² have shown a **marked improvement in 90.9% of cases**. This covers both indicators of mental wellbeing
