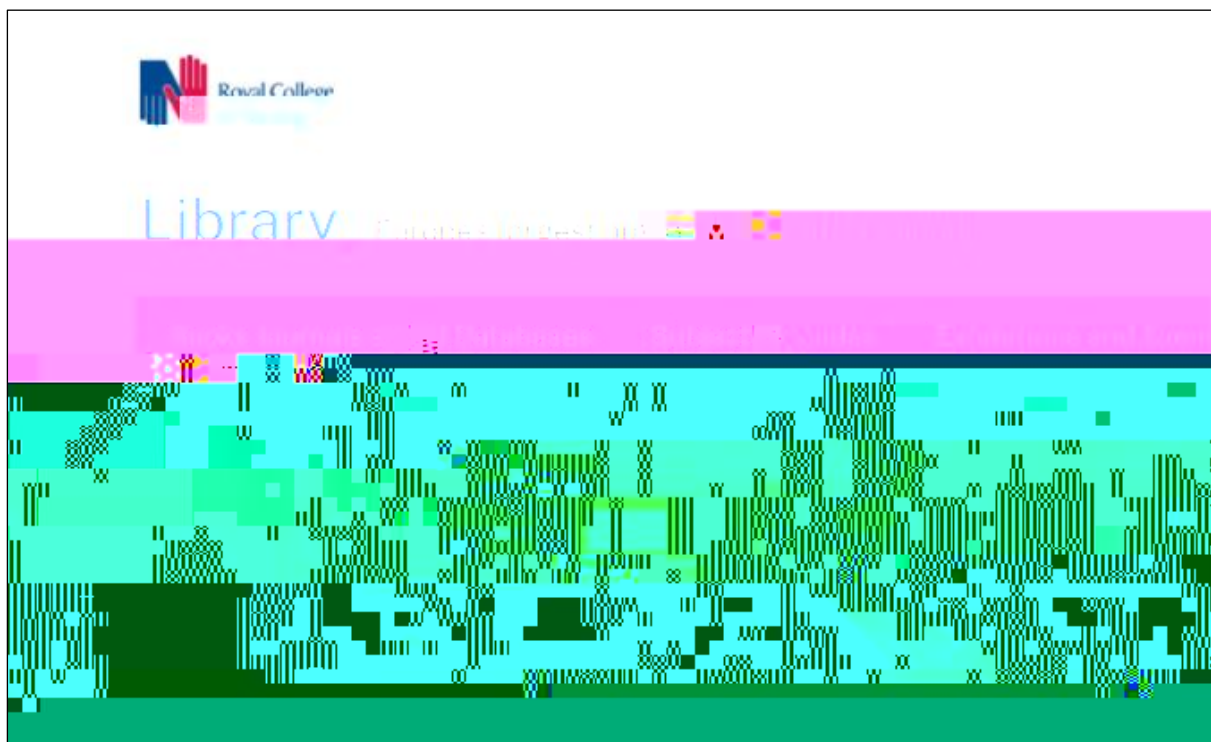

Step 1

Searching for RCN publications, including those past their review date is best done through the Library catalogue

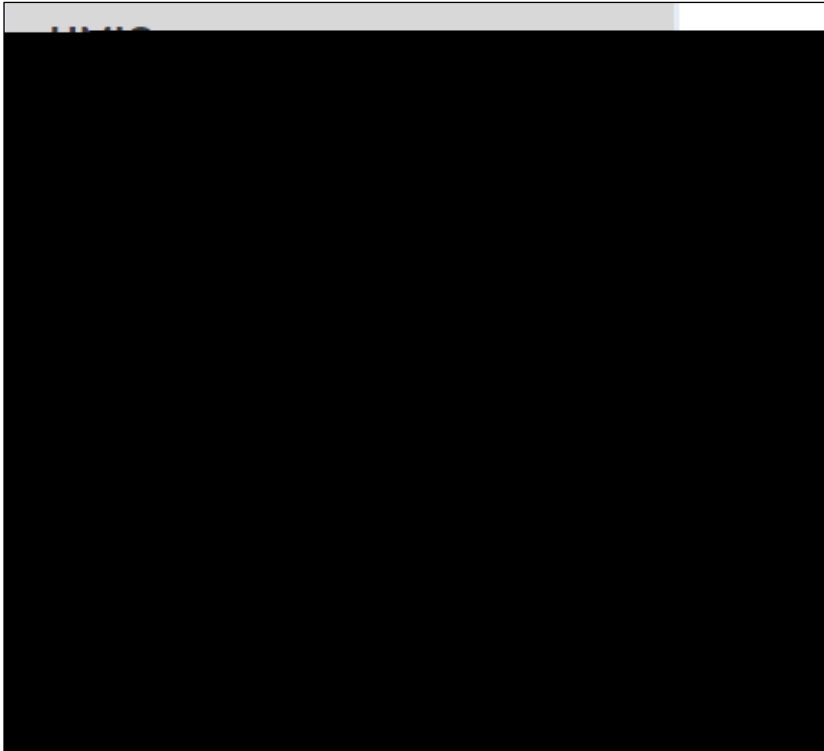
Go to www.rcn.org.uk/library

Click on the **Books Journals and Databases** tab



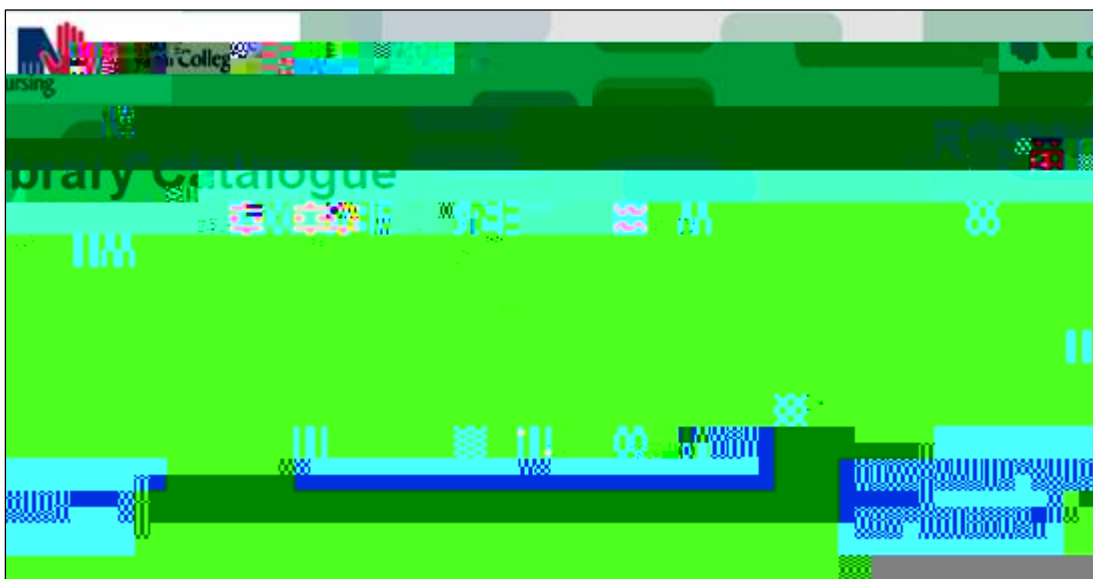
Step 2

Scroll down the page and click on **RCN Library catalogue**

Click on the **Advanced Search** option



Step 4

Scroll down to 'Collections' and use the dropdown option to search for RCN Publications or RCN Endorsed Publications

Type in your keyword in the **words or phrase** box or you can add subject headings
